- **Hoped For** – In Genesis 21, we are reminded of the story of Sarah and Abraham. Much like them, we are believing God for a miracle in the form of a child. The Kayson Kids Team is joined with God’s to pray and believe God for the heavens to invade the earth. We pray for God to help our families to conceive child(ren), adopt, foster, receive parental guardianship of family members, and to pray for healthy pregnancies, births etc. If you need a support system for anything pertaining to prayer for a child, this is where we hope and pray. For four consecutive weeks, we will host a small group to meet with you and your families for testimonials. Those that are tough to bear alone and those that we celebrate and rejoice for the good works of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
- **Living** – There are adults all across the globe who struggle with their individual identity. A part of that is never receiving the knowledge of who they are in Christ at an early age (see the biblical parable of Cain and Abel in Genesis 4). It is also the disadvantage of never being celebrated. Jealousy, hate and envy has overtaken the hearts and minds of many people, due to them not feeling seen, heard, loved, liked, or respected. If we are celebrated, the chances of us wanting to rob someone else of their shine is less likely. On the birthday of your loved one, The Kayson Kids Team is at their service. We will select a venue with cake, decorations, party favors and the whole nine yards. we’ll even sing “HAPPY BIRTHDAY!!” Every human being matters, and we are all created in His image.
- **Deceased** – It is one of the most catastrophic events for a parent to bury or cremate their child. We all have hopes and dreams of growing old with our children. Bathsheba and King David were examples in the Bible of parents who suffered the loss of an infant son in 2 Samuel. How we’ve lost the child doesn’t make the pain any less. Whether it be a miscarriage, an abortion that someone is



forced to have or of that was someone's decision at the moment, time progressed, and they regretted their decision. We lose children to gun violence, SIDS, premature births, cancer, drownings, etc. Wouldn't it be nice to have someone to help you to celebrate the life of your deceased child rather than just allowing it to be a memory? There are so many mothers who have suffered the loss of children by miscarriage. Some of these women are not acknowledged on Mother's Day because the child isn't physically here. Anything that we suppress will cause internal bleeding. The Kayson Kids Team would like to pray for you and for you and your family.
